## **Tallinn Music Week announces festival programme**

**The 6<sup>th</sup> Tallinn Music Week, taking place from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> of March sees 227 artists from 20 countries in the programme. Concert tickets and festival passes for 45 € are on sale.**

Since the first Tallinn Music Week in 2009, the festival has become the mecca for many of the artists in the Baltic Nordic region. Tallinn Music Week 2014 has 145 local and 79 international acts in the programme. 19 of them come from Finland, 11 from both Latvia and Lithuania, 7 from Russia, 4 from Belarus and Denmark, and 3 from both Iceland and United Kingdom.

International highlights this year include widely acclaimed Britishretro-futurist duo **Public Service Broadcasting** who weave old propaganda and information films around live instruments and electronic sounds; mystical yet insatiably catchy **BRNS** from Belgium; new kids on the 80s synth-block, **Ballet School** from Germany, and promising post-rock trio **Everything is Made in China** from Russia.

Estonian music at Tallinn Music Week is represented by 145 acts from various genres, among them Universal signee, multitalent, and the winner of both the best electronic album and best male act prizes at this year's Estonian Music Awards, **Leslie Da Bass**; female-led and hard-rockin' combo **Sibyl Vane** who have toured extensively all over Europe during the last year; the daring and deranged metal-punk sextet **Winnie Puhh** who have made a stir from Vogue to Milan Fashion Week; last year's Skype Award winners **Elephants From Neptune**, and the godfathers of Estonian indie, **Röövel Ööbik**.

As in previous years, TMW's **City Stage** programme will yet again spread festival moods all over Tallinn offering free of charge daytime/afternoon concerts by in bookstores and record shops, cafés, galleries and other unexpected places.

Last year's debutant, restaurant festival TMW Tastes will also be part of this year's activities, introducing the loveliest restaurants and eateries and offering special chef's menus to festival visitors. The **City Stage** programme and TMW Tastes participants will be announced on 17<sup>th</sup> of February.

In 2013 around 17,000 music fans took part in different festival activities and close to 800 music industry delegates signed up to participate at TMW as an industry pro. As the festival's role of bringing together the region's new music makers and admirers, has grown steadily, the festival is expecting to host more happy punters from neighbouring countries and all around Europe this year.
